The Edizione Story

The challenge put to Farnese by Hugh Johnson: make a wine that represents the Italian winemaking tradition in the vein of a Super Tuscan but crafted with indigenous grape varieties native to Abruzzo and Puglia.

The 1000 year old traditions were all put into one wine. After careful research, Filippo Baccalaro and French winemaker Jean-Marc Saboua succeeded in finding 5 indigenous varieties (cinque autoctoni) Montepulciano, Sangiovese, Primitivo, Negroamaro and Malvasia Nera. These were blended in different percentages obtain the final result. Edizione does not have a vintage as the grapes come from two different regions; even if the vintages are the same the wine is named with the progressive edition number of the vintage produced.

The result reveals all the warm character of "Southern Italy".

The very first edition was submitted to the Sydney International Wine show where it won not only a gold medal but the overall trophy for best non-Australian wine of the show! This set the pattern for every successive edition.
